

Proposed changes to Standing Committees:

1. Drop Boys & Girls (immediately) and Concession Stand (effective 6/30/14).
2. Rename Convention to Zone and District Involvement
3. Combine Attendance and Greeter Committees and designate Lion Tamer as chair.
4. Establish a Public Relations committee that would focus on promoting the club and club activities to non-members.
5. Add Internal to the name of the Club Communications committee, making its focus communications among members about the club, e.g., the list serve, the e-newsletter, directory, etc.
6. Change the name of the Civic Improvement Committee to Community Service Committee. The committee will coordinate service projects that do not involve expenditure of significant funds. It will coordinate the "Adopt a Highway" project, Habitat for Humanity workdays, Weiner Fest judging, etc., and propose additional projects.
7. Change the name of the Health and Public Service Committee to Health and Wellness. It will have responsibility for
8. Diabetes Awareness, eyeglasses recycling, eye exams and glasses, etc. General "public service" projects would be part of the responsibility of the Community Service Committee.
9. Add Food and Social to the Standing Committees.
10. Add International Relations to the Standing Committees
11. Add the Fundraiser Review Committee as a special committee to review current projects and develop new ideas.
12. Committees formed for fundraising projects would be special committees until the longevity of the fundraiser is established.

Note: The Nomination Committee is organized under Article IV §2 by Presidential appointment in January or February. It shall include at least one past president and the current First Vice President.

Note: The Membership Committee, organized under Art. IV §6, is composed of three members serving staggered terms. The 1st-year member and chair is the Immediate Past-President. The 2nd-year member is the previous year's chair, and the 3rd-year member was the chair 2 years before.
